- Meeting called to order at 6:07 by Jaimie Wolf
- Meeting minutes from 12 Sep 2019 unanimously approved
- Matt Reynolds presentation on Preliminary 2019 School Performance Framework focused on 1 year review which is more actionable than the 3 year data set
 - **BLUF: We're doing well**
 - Framework is approved in December with action plan made in April
 - Growth data is valued more than achievement data
 - Performance point will increase from 53% to 61% in two years (2021)
 - Increasing data point measurements from 2 to 3: Achievement, Growth, and Growth to Standard in 2 years
 - Accountability is based on the average, not the proficiency
 - Comparison year is 2016
- Academic Achievement Scores

- Subgroups are compared to the overall, not in isolation
- Science is only 5th grade, English and Math are grades 3-6
- Academic Growth
 - Growth data count will be less than Growth due to ability to monitor each individual's growth
 - "Growth" is how you compare to statewide academic peer group, not personal
- PGE scores compared to last year
 - Went from 77.4 to 70.5 from last year to this year
 - Increased average in both ELA and Math
 - Growth scores went down
 - Performance/achievement is improving
- Responsibility of PGE
 - Create 2-year plan
- Principal update: 552 enrollment, projected was 543
- Teacher update:
 - PLC day: Mindful classroom, social-psycho-emotional growth, self-study about more guided reading; John Smith: Trauma-informed training
 - Investigating new math programs for K-6; visiting other schools to see the potential curriculum in action
- PGEA update: next meeting Dec. 3 at 6:30 at a parent's house
 - Panther Prowl \$29, 627
 - Rent the Rock is beginning
- DAC update: no rep present
- Open Discussion
 - Boundary and Capacity study is beginning soon: email and social media campaign to promote participation; first time this will be done in 10 years
