- Meeting called to order by Ryan Vaughn
- Teacher Update
 - Michelle Bender - Planning end of year celebrations with protocols in place; testing recess combining classes at grade levels which kids are really grateful; starting to plan for next year classes
- Update on Boundary Capacity & Analysis
 - Overview: Prairie Crossing boundary analysis will affect PGE as a Chap feeder school due to housing development and exceeding capacity.
 - 16F scenario as top option currently - this includes unbuilt housing in Carousel Farms and Newling Crossing moving to PGE - A pro is the boundaries will move prior to students moving in
 - PGE will add 1 mobile this summer in anticipation of capacity growth
 - Choice enrollment - PGE 33%; Prairie Cross 8%; PGE more unpredictable so boundary increase will help with predictable enrollment
- Summer Construction at PGE

- Due to bond passing last year- Tier 2 construction happening this summer - new kitchen floor, student restroom partitions replaced, make up & condensing unit replacement; water repellent and join work outside
- BASE will still be at PGE this summer. BASE students may need to be in mobile, outside as applicable, and use adult restrooms pending where construction is taking place.
- Revisit DAC Priority Questionnaire & state budget update
 - Annual questionnaire – Results back - High priorities for county SAC's are to restore furlough days for staff, transportation, SBB funding, operations & maintenance, teaching & learning curriculum.
 - Reviewed slide for proposals of budget for DCSD next year; example full calendar year (no furlough days)
 - State budget looking at 8.5% increase to revenue in 21-22 which will help schools - will find out in June when budget finalized
- Staffing Update
 - Enrollment Projection: 532 for 21-22
 - PGE will go down by 1 section (2nd grade)
- Discuss SAC positions for next year
 - Will keep positions same for next year; mix up virtual and in person meetings if protocols permit
 - SAC to discuss hosting event in spring
