- Review PGE's School Performance Framework (Matt Reynolds- DCSD Assessment Officer)
  - o School Performance Framework (SPF): Data for school assessment are finalized in December. Based on the data, PGE has met criteria ("green") for two years in a row and now PGE can defer submitting a plan to the state this year and continue with the two year plan already in place.
  - o Data are gathered from statewide assessments (e.g. CMAS)
  - o PGE has a "Performance Plan" (top category)
    - Academic growth is weighted over academic achievement in overall assessment
    - Increased participation rate in 2017 yielded more accurate and representative data for PGE.
    - **Academic Achievement:** PGE students overall are exceeding in CMAS English Language Arts (ELA; "blue"). PGE is meeting State and Federal standards ("green") in all groups and categories except students with disabilities in CMAS Science and CMAS ELA. This group in these two

categories are approaching (“yellow”) standards. However, this group’s scores improved from 2016 in which they were not meeting criteria (“red”) in the same two categories.

- **Academic Growth:** PGE is meeting State and Federal standards in all categories (“green”). This is improved over the year prior in which PGE was approaching (“yellow”) or not meeting (“red”) standards in all categories.
  - Overall students participation on state assessment is up, contributing to an increase in scores.
- Discuss upcoming unified Chap feeder meeting (Jeff)
    - o Meeting is tentative due to scheduling conflicts. Consequently, it may be cancelled/rescheduled. It is currently scheduled for February 1, 2018, 6:30-8:00pm at Sierra

    - o Teachers met with Janet Merrill (DCSD trainor) about guided reading strategies.
    - o January 12 PLC day, teachers worked on Wonders curriculum training and other teaching initiatives
    - o Judy Branch (PLS - certified) and Gina Wolpi (B.A.S.E. Director - classified) both received Apple awards for Pine Grove and will be honored at the DCSD Apple Awards ceremony on April 21
