Your son/daughter will be given a schedule in time for you to make arrangements for pick up at 5:10 PM sharp, in front of the school in the west parking lot. There is no charge for this program; however, your child must be picked up by 5:10 PM.

## Course Descriptions

**A.M. Early Stingrays Study Hall** - This course is designed to allow students the opportunity to be on campus early, in a supervised environment, to work on homework or classwork. The course is held in the Cafeteria. Breakfast is also available starting at 8:30 AM.

**A.M. Morning Media Lab** – This course is designed to allow students to use the computers before classes. Room 1-135

**PM. ESOL Computer Lab** – This course is designed for ELL students to integrate with educational technology. Room 3-206

**PM. Homework Assistance Math.**– This course is designed to allow students to receive tutoring in Math, extra help with classwork/homework. Room 3-201.

**PM. Homework Assistance Language Arts** – This course is designed to allow students to receive tutoring in English Language Arts, extra help with classwork/homework. Room 1-143.

**PM.Science Club Robotics** – This club is designed for those who are interested in LEGO Robotics. Classroom 3-120.

**PM.Basketball PM** – This course is designed to allow students to engage in free play sports activities. The course is held on the outside basketball courts and gymnasium.
